The six-session series fosters discussion among all ages on issues that are central in early adulthood and supports those who are looking for answers to questions about faith, sexuality, values related to technology and the new media, vocation and work. It concludes with an exploration of the stages of faith development to help churches understand and learn how to encourage those younger adults.
